Student must be in good health and must be physically able to perform first aid related procedures, instructor may request a medical exam by a doctor which must be completed before student receives final certification. Student textbook & student guide must be purchased before class starts; this will secure your spot in the upcoming course. PLEASE NOTE: there is prereading to be completed before the first day of the course.

Students who are unsuccessful after 2 examinations will be required to do another 2-week course. The second course will be free to students provided they maintain 100% attendance in the initial course, this will be up to the agency's discretion; however, the exam fee will still apply.
